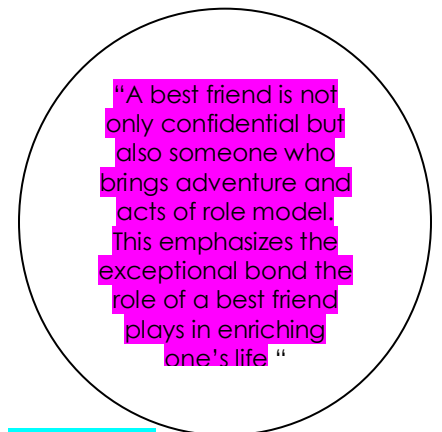

when you are upset. This metaphor suggests that a friend can play a nurturing role, providing the same level of care and empathy that a parent might give.

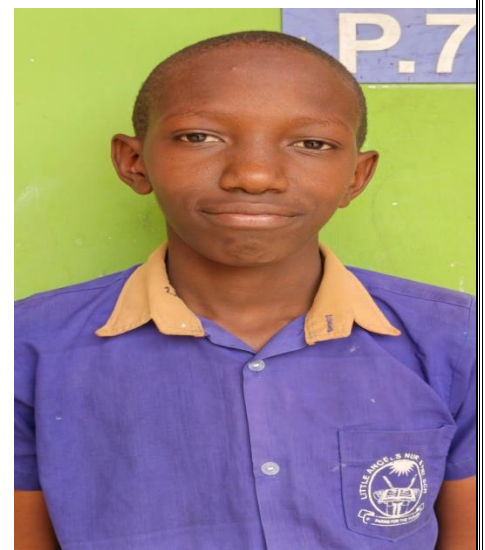
